

P.E. and sport premium spend 2016-2017

Schools with 17 or more pupils receive £8,000 plus £5 per child.

This funding must be used to fund improvements to the provision of PE and sport, for the benefit of primary-aged pupils, so that they develop healthy lifestyles.

Spending and **impact** of sports premium at Euxton Church of England Primary School 2016 - 2017

Membership to Chorley School Sports Partnership (SSP)

Access to Level 1, 2, 3, Competitions, Football and Netball Leagues, and Inclusion Festivals for R, KS1 and KS2.

Access to music and singing workshops.

Additional swimming tuition for Year 4 (Sep to Feb) (in addition to year 3 swimming Feb to July)

2 years of quality swimming tuition provided, including water safety.

Children also compete in the swimming gala through Chorley SSP.
