Reading

It is very important that children keep up their reading and read regularly to an adult. To encourage enjoyment of reading and ensure that your child understands what they have read, it is helpful to discuss the events of the story, talk about characters and why/why not they like the book. Please refer to your child's book band bookmark and reading prompts in their reading record. Children can also complete the book reviews in their reading record.
