Use my knowledge of root words, prefixes and suffixes to read and understand new words.

Read tricky words, noticing the unusual correspondences between spelling and sounds.

Identify and discuss words and phrases that capture my interest

Discuss what words mean in the context of the text

Identify how texts are presented, answering questions such as... Why is the text presented and organised as it is?

Use dictionaries to check the meaning of words I am not sure of.

When reading aloud, show that I understand the text by reading with expression, changing voice for exclamation, question and speech marks.

Predict what might happen, using clues in the text that I have already read to help me.

Use clues in the text to make inferences such as how a character feels, what they are thinking, why they act in a certain way.

Discuss the ideas and themes in the books I have read.

Retrieve and record information from nonfiction, using contents, indexes and scanning Ask questions so that I can understand texts better.

Identify how texts have been structured, eg titles, subheadings, labels, diagrams and charts Identify the main ideas in each section of a text, describing them in a few words.
