#### School Attendance

As a school, we regularly monitor pupil attendance and we have recently been visited by an attendance officer from the local authority. We understand that some absences are unavoidable e.g. an illness. Our current average school attendance is 96.3%. For every 5% of absence at this stage in the year, it equates to approximately 3 missed days of school or around 15 hours of learning. Pupils whose attendance falls below 90% are in danger of significantly underachieving and classed as being persistently absent. From next term, we are going to start communicating with parents via letter if your child's attendance falls below recommended guidelines. We may also ask parents for a meeting to discuss how to improve your child's attendance and find ways to further support families. Addressing attendance is a nationwide priority for schools and we thank you for your support with this.
