School Attendance

As a school, we regularly monitor pupil attendance and we have recently been visited by an attendance officer from the local authority. We understand that some absences are unavoidable e.g. an illness. Our current average school attendance is 96.2%. For every 5% of absence at this stage in the year, it equates to approximately 3 missed days of school or around 15 hours of learning. Pupils whose attendance falls below 90% are in danger of significantly underachieving and classed as being persistently absent. From next term, we are going to start communicating with parents via letter if your child's attendance falls below recommended guidelines. We may also ask parents for a meeting to discuss how to improve your child's attendance and find ways to further support families. Addressing attendance is a nationwide priority for schools and we thank you for your support with this.

Year 1 Hearing Tests

The school health team are back in school on Wednesday 7th February to screen the children's hearing. Consent forms have gone home in book bags this week - please could parents return the completed consent form before we break up for Christmas next Friday if possible. Thank you.

We are so proud of everyone for 'SHINING' at Out of School Club.



We just want to let you know about some of the things that we have been getting up to in Out of School Club.

During the mornings, now they are darker and cooler, the key stage 2 children (Years 3-6) have been in the hall playing with their new board games that have been kindly donated. The children are all really enjoying playing with them, thank you so much for your donations.

The key stage 1 children (Reception-Year 2) have the space in our extension area for games and toys to enjoy playing with their classmates and friends.

After school in key stage 2, when the weather has been kind, the children have been able to get outside and play on the playground. Some of the children have been excited to use the hall laptop to play music and 'Just Dance' for everyone to join in with.

Key stage 1 have been making lots of Christmas crafts which have either been put on display in the extension room or have been taken home.

Just a couple of reminders. There is no use of the school driveway in the morning and we stop serving breakfast at 8.30am as this gives us time to clear and put away ready for the school day. In the evening, the school driveway can be used from 4.45pm until we close at 5.30pm.

For parents collecting children from the key stage 1 area, the gate will be left open for you to come and knock on the door to let staff know you are here. We will keep the gate open until February half term, as it will be getting lighter by then and the children will be back outside using the outdoor area.
