Nut Free School

Please can I remind parents that we are a nut free school. On lunch duty this week I have noticed some items in lunch boxes which may contain nuts e.g. Kinder/Nutella/sesame items. Our 'no nut' rule means that nuts, and products containing nuts, may not be brought into school. A severe nut allergy can be life threatening. Since we have several children in school who suffer from a severe nut

allergy, it is essential that children who have an allergy do not come into contact with nuts or nut products. Thank you for your co-operation with this.
