Topic theme 'Seedlings, Saplings and Shoots'

Our topic this half term is mainly lead by our **Science** focus of investigating plants. We will explore and investigate the different components of plants, their functions as well as understanding the plant's needs and life as a whole.



RE

In R.E. our unit of study is Judaism. We will be exploring the relationship between God and His people with a focus on Moses' leadership.

English and Maths

In these lessons we will continue to build on all the hard work and progress so far this year; taking your child's learning and knowledge onto the next level.

English

This half term we'll explore grammar focuses of nouns, adjectives and prepositions by reading traditional poems. Then we'll discuss the features of written dialogue in play scripts. We'll also be doing lots of cross curricular writing linked to our Science topic, identifying structural features e.g. *text boxes, flow charts, sub-headings, bullet points, glossary, diagrams.*

Maths

In mathematics this half term, we will be focusing on multiplication facts, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division in the context of measures and money. We'll also be sorting 2D and 3D shapes.
